Since the beginning of China's economic reforms and development, modernisation theorists have always been in the front-line when it came down to predicting the country's soonto-come political liberalisation. However, after decades of contradictory results of quantitative studies on the alleged causal relationship between economic development and democracy, there is growing consent to Seymour Martin Lipset s statement that [w]hether democracy succeeds or fails continues to depend significantly on the choices, behaviors, and decisions of political leaders and groups (Lipset 1994: 18). Completely in line with what the German political scientist Wolfgang Muno describes as the need for qualitative analyses of [] important actors, concepts and strategies (Muno...
