The moon being much nearer the earth than the sun, the effect of parallax is very much greater, which makes a larger correction for the altitude. The sun is 95,000,000 miles distant, and its parallax is only a few seconds at most; and in observations taken at sea for latitude, to the nearest minute only, it may be wholly neglected, as was done in the cases just given. But the moon is on an average of only about 239,000 miles distant from it; although its distance varies considerably, and its parallax varies with its distance, it being 61J nearly, when the moon is nearest, and less than 54 when it...
