It also captures an earlier age of university life, when students drank sherry and scaled college walls to escape prowling Bulldogs. Illustrated with the author s own sketches, engravings, and calligraphy, this book is both an atmospheric account of 1940s Oxford and a fascinating Oriental view of one of Britain s bestloved cities.
