S., president of the chemical section of the British Association for the Advancement of Science, gave an address at the Birmingham meeting in September, in which he undertook with great skill aud learning to adapt the doctrine of evolution to the chemical elements. After glancing at the difficulty of defining an element he noticed the revolt of many physicists aud chemists against the ordinary acceptation of the term. He next considered the improbability of their eternal selfexistence or their origination by chance. He suggested as a remaiuiug alternative their origin by a process of evolution, like that of the heavenly bodies according to Laplace.
