It is hoped that all of the important items are included and that a sufficient number of citations are given to make them accessible to all readers. State papers, although they emanated from the State Department and often bore signature of the Secretary of State but whose composition may be attributed to Mr. Wilson, have been freely listed and have been included in their chronological order. Proclamations have been listed separately only when their interest seemed to warrant. All proclamations have been listed collectively under the year, as in the United States statutes at large.
